



## Estate Hawke's Bay Late Harvest 2010

### Winemaking

Ripe Pinot Gris and Chardonnay fruit with great flavour and intensity was used to make this sweet, luscious wine. The blend is 64% Pinot Gris and 36% Chardonnay. The juice was fermented with temperature control to optimise fruit character and richness.

### Characteristics

The nose has ripe peach and apricot aromas with hints of grapefruit and pineapple. In the mouth there are lovely intense flavours that start from a lush upfront palate, and lead on to a clean, fresh finish. The palate has a good balance between sweetness and acidity; sweet without being cloying and lingering on the aftertaste.

### Cellar Potential

The wine will develop bottle age characters and complexity over the next two to three years.
